AVMA Animal Welfare Award

DATE ESTABLISHED - 1989.

ORIGIN - Established by the AVMA Executive Board as part of Animal Welfare Week.

BASIS OF AWARD - The award is given to a member of the AVMA who has advanced animal well-being, shown exemplary dedication to animal care, and contributed to the community and society. The nominee's achievements can be through any or all of the following areas: Leadership, Public Service, Volunteer Service, Research Findings, Product Development, Public Policy Development, Animal, Advocacy, and Humane Education. The accomplishments may be based upon a sustained effort, or an extraordinary single achievement.

SELECTION - The recipient is selected by the AVMA Executive Board from three finalists selected by the Animal Welfare Committee.

THE AWARD - A 12-inch clear lucite pyramid enclosing the Aesculapian Staff with the winner's name engraved on the base.

Bustad Companion Animal Veterinarian of the Year Award

DATE ESTABLISHED - 1985.

ORIGIN - Established by Hill's Pet Nutrition, Inc. together with the Delta Society and the American Veterinary Medical Association. Approved by the Executive Board to recognize veterinary achievements and contributions in the human-animal bond field. The award is named in honor of Dr. Leo K. Bustad, former dean at Washington State University, a pioneer in the study of human-animal interactions, and president of the Delta Society.

BASIS OF AWARD - To recognize a distinguished member of the veterinary profession for pioneering work in the human-animal bond field.

SELECTION - The AVMA and the Delta Society are responsible for soliciting and evaluating nominations from state veterinary medical associations. A six-member national judging panel is comprised of three Delta Society representatives, a member of the Council on Communications, an AVMA member appointed by the president, and a member of the Committee on the Human-Animal Bond.

THE AWARD - A specially- designed plaque and a \$2,500 grant to the winner With a matching \$2,500 to the veterinary college of his/her choice. The award ceremonies are held in the recipient's hometown and mark the kick-off of National Pet Week that takes place during the first full week in May.

Royal Canin Award

SELECTION - The recipient is selected by the AVMA Executive Board.

XIIth International Veterinary Congress Prize

DATE ESTABLISHED - 1936.

ORIGIN - Unexpended balance of fund raised for the entertainment of delegates to the XIIth International Veterinary Congress held in New York in 1934. The U. S. Committee on Finance of that Congress met on April 15, 1936, to consider utilization of the unexpended money and voted that the sum of \$5,000 should be turned over to the AVMA for investment in U.S. Treasury bonds, the interest to be used each year for an award to be known as the XIIth International Veterinary Congress Prize. (The fund is designated by the AVMA as "Special Fund No. 2")

BASIS OF AWARD - To recognize outstanding service by a member of the Association who has contributed to international understanding of veterinary medicine.

SELECTION - The recipient is selected by the AVMA Executive Board.

THE AWARD - A Tiffany crystal sculpture and cash award in the amount of \$500.
