Background

Rescue teams are beginning to pull back now as more aid groups move in to replace them. There is a concern over the short fall in aid, especially with the numbers of people affected.

More survivors have been found in among the rubble, 3 children were pulled out of buildings by American rescue teams over night. A floating hospital has been positioned off the coast near PaP which can take the load off medical aid agencies overwhelmed with numbers on the ground.
