***Background***

There is growing anger over President Preval and the public perception that he has not done enough to get things moving again in PaP. However there are some tensions between the government and aid agencies over the money raised not being handed over to the government. Some petrol stations are back up and running which is making transport around the capital easier

***Key Messages***

***General Overview of the Humanitarian Situation***

Many aid agencies have had to provide councilors and support staff to their staff in the field due to the difficult working conditions. Still outlying camps on the edge of PaP haven't seen any aid packages reach them. This is causing serious distress and upset as those people scabble to find enough food to keep them going. They continue to wait for aid to turn up. People across the city are desperately seeking employment anywhere they can, desperate to earn some money so that they can feed their families.
