Background

Haiti's main fuel tanker terminal has been repaired. This now means shipments of fuel can resume which will help a sense of normality return to the capital. The state-owned power company Electricite d'Haiti has also restore electricity to small parts of the city.

The official death toll is standing at 230,000 people, but this does not include those bodies still trapped under the rubble. The number of dead is now reaching the total death toll caused by the Asian tsunami of 2004.
