Background

There was a 3 day period of national mourning across Haiti. This was mostly held in the form of outdoor masses-these services were a mixture of memorial services and rallies against the government.

Key Messages

General Overview of the Humanitarian Situation

United Nation's humanitarian chief John Holmes said the emergency medical care phase of dealing with earthquake trauma patients was "mostly over", with the priorities now on providing shelter and sanitation. This is in light of only 30 to 35% of the waterproof shelter needed having been built already.
