Standard 11 – Outcomes Assessment

Major Deficiency:

The Council on Education expects that 80% or more of each college's graduating senior students sitting for the NAVLE will have passed at the time of graduation. Colleges that do not meet this criterion will be subjected to the following analysis. The Council will calculate an exact 95% binomial confidence interval for the NAVLE scores for colleges whose NAVLE pass rate falls below 80%. Colleges with an upper limit of an exact 95% binomial confidence interval less than 85% for two successive years in which scores are available will be placed on Probationary Accreditation.
